ORDINANCE NO. 1182

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 54 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF MINDEN, KEARNEY COUNTY, NEBRASKA, BY AMENDING SECTION 54-66(c) AND 54-66(d), AS THE SAME RELATES TO THE RECREATION BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINDEN, KEARNEY COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That Section 54-66 (c) and Section 54-66 (d) of the Municipal Code of the City of Minden, Kearney County, Nebraska, be amended to read as follows:

Section 54-66(c). Membership. In order for the board to carry out the responsibilities described in subsection (b) of this section it should consist of a membership that includes a number of organizations. Therefore, the recreation board will include the recreation director, and five members which will be appointed by the mayor and approved by the city council. Two of the appointed members will serve one year terms and three of the members shall serve two year terms. After the initial one year appointment, the position shall then be for a two year term.

Section 54-66 (d). Representation; meeting schedule. When considering appointments to the recreations board the mayor may first consider individuals that represent youth organizations of the city. The board shall meet in the following months: February, March, April, May, September and October and otherwise as it shall determine. All other meeting dates and times shall be arranged by the recreation board.

Section 2. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 1182 and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
