ORDINANCE NO. 1190

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF MINDEN, KEARNEY COUNTY, NEBRASKA BY ADDING ARTICLE I, SECTION 2-1 AND SECTION 2-2, (a)(b) and (c), TO THE CITY CODE AS THE SAME RELATES TO PURCHASES MADE BY THE CITY AND THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH PURCHASES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINDEN, KEARNEY COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Article I, Section 2-1 is hereby added to the City Code of the City of Minden, Kearney County, Nebraska, to wit:

Article I, Section 2-1, Bidding Requirements. Any purchases made by the City of Minden, Kearney County, Nebraska in excess of \$30,000.00, shall be submitted to a competitive bidding process and shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder.

Section 2. That Article I, Section 2-2 is hereby added to the City Code of the City of Minden, Kearney County, Nebraska, to wit:

Article I, Section 2-2, Exceptions. There shall be excepted from Article I, Section 2-1 the following purchases:

a) Upon City Council approval, purchases made in cooperation with the State of Nebraska and its' statewide purchasing pool which is made in a competitive bidding process; and,

b) Upon City Council approval, purchases of unique items or equipment which are produced or manufactured in limited quantity or on special order by a very limited or small number of manufacturers'; and,

c) Purchases made in response to emergency needs of the City, occasioned by natural disasters, national emergencies and any other emergency situation wherein such purchases are made to protect persons or property of the City or residents of the City of Minden, Kearney County, Nebraska.

Section 3. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 1190, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
